

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Researchers from Population-based Cancer Registries of latin countries are invited to submit abstracts for oral communications and posters of the Annual Meeting of GRELL.

We ask authors to follow these instructions scrupulously to facilitate the compilation of abstracts.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

1. The abstract must be written in English.
2. The title of the abstract should contain no more than 30 words.
3. A maximum of 10 authors belonging to up to five different institutions should be specified.
4. The body of the abstract should contain no more than 350 words.
5. The abstract should include the following parts: Objectives, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
6. The abstract should not contain any table or figure, nor references.
7. The abstract must be submitted using the Submission Form available below.
8. Authors may indicate a preference for the type of presentation: E-Poster or Oral communication.
9. Authors under 35 years of age will be eligible for the award as long as they are the first author of the communication and make the presentation. The authors must indicate if they are under 35 years old in the Submission Form.
10. Participants registered to attend via streaming will not be able to make Oral communications, only E-Posters.
11. Participants registered to attend the meeting in person will be able to make Oral or E-Poster communications. If your preference is Oral communication, make sure you will attend in person.
12. During the abstract submission, participants will be asked for consent for the transmission by streaming in case of Oral communication.
13. Abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee, which will decide the acceptance of contributions and the mode of presentation.
14. Notification of acceptance or rejection of the abstract will be sent to the author indicated for correspondence, up to two weeks after the deadline for submission.
15. The author, or at least one of the coauthors, must be registered to the meeting for the definitive acceptance of the communication.
16. The abstracts of all accepted communications will appear in the Book of Abstracts, which will be accessible on the Grell website.
17. Accepted E-Posters will be displayed on digital screens at the Congress venue and will be accessible through a link on the Grell website during the meeting.



Deadline for submission of abstracts:
17th of March 2022.

Each contribution will be assessed independently by two reviewers. Only contributions aiming to issues inherent to population cancer registries will be accepted.

We seek to ensure a maximum representation of cancer registries of Latin languages countries accredited or in process of accreditation.

Multiple contributions from the same institution will be evaluated on the basis of the relevance of the topics covered and the availability of oral communications.
